Root Words Focus: *pon, pos, pose (to put, place, or set)*

1. **component** - one of several parts that are put together to make up a whole machine
2. **exponent** - a number placed above and to the right of a number or letter to show how many times that quantity is multiplied by itself
3. **opponent** - someone you "put a stop to" (defeat) in a game, fight, or argument
4. **postpone** - to change a set date or time of a planned event to another
5. **proponent** - someone who puts their support in something or persuades people to do something
6. **deposit** - to put money into an account
7. **disposable** - intended to be used once or for a short time then put in the trash
8. **imposition** - something that is a burden to someone else; to put your needs above someone else's to the point that it's a burden for others
9. **preposition** -word that is put before a noun to show place, time, direction, etc.
10. **proposal** - a plan or offer that is usually put down in writing
11. **compose** - to carefully put thoughts down on paper to write a letter, poem, story, etc.; to try hard to seem calm and not upset, angry, or excited
12. **decompose** - to decay or make something decay; to break down a set of numbers
13. **expose** - to put something out for others to see
14. **suppose** - to place your confidence in something you think is true, although you are uncertain
15. **transpose** - to put into a different order or place; to reverse or transfer the order
