

Before I send my child to campus today, I'm going to ask these three questions:



1

Has my child displayed any of the symptoms related to COVID 19 (unusual to your child)?

- Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath/difficult breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea



Contact the campus nurse.

Student must stay off campus until 1) at least 10 calendar days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND 2) at least 24 hours have passed with no fever without the use of meds. A student may return prior to meeting the criteria with a doctor's note clearing the student for return or obtaining a COVID infection test and receiving a negative result. If the student feels well enough, coordinate with the campus to pick up lessons and continue learning so that students don't fall behind.

Has my child been in contact with someone who has tested POSITIVE for COVID19?



Was the student within 6 feet of a positive case for 15 minutes or more?



Return to campus, but monitor for symptoms. If symptoms develop, go to question 1.

Students may return to the campus. Parents have the option to keep students at home but are not required to unless the student begins to show symptoms. If a parent opts to keep a student home due to close contact, the close contact must be documented and submitted to the campus for approval. The student will be expected to continue learning at home. Parents will coordinate with campuses to pick up lessons for the student to complete until they return (no more than 10 calendar days).

Has my child tested positive for COVID-19? (Note: If your child has been tested for COVID 19 due to symptoms, the child should remain home until the results are available.)



Contact the campus nurse.

If the student feels well enough, coordinate with the campus to pick up lessons and continue the learning. until 1) at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared OR the date of the test, AND 2) at least 24 hours have passed with no fever without the use of meds.
