



## Texas Academic Performance Report for 2014-15

### Arlington Classics Academy

in compliance with TEC Ch. 39

January 21, 2016

Texas Education Code Chapter 39 requires that Arlington Classics Academy's board of trustees publish an annual report that includes the Texas Academic Performance Report as prepared by the Texas Education Agency, campus performance objectives, a report of violent or criminal incidents, and information received under Texas Education Code §51.043(e) from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

#### **Section 1 – Texas Academic Performance Report**

Section 1 provides the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) as prepared by the Texas Education Agency for our district and each campus. Due to the length of the reports, they are attached as addendum A. These reports provide information concerning student body performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) as well as information on student enrollment, class size, and financial expenditures.

The report for our school may or may not have all of the information described because the information presented depends on whether the school is an elementary, middle or high school. State law requires that the TAPR display information about the state, the district, and the school. Where possible, the information must be reported by race/ethnicity and socio-economic status of the students and must include at least two years of results.

ACA is proud to continue a legacy of excellence in our instructional program having received the highest available rating from the Texas Education Agency with distinction designations in:

- Academic Achievement in Reading/English Language Arts**
- Academic Achievement in Mathematics**
- Academic Achievement in Social Studies**
- Top 25 Percent: Closing Performance Gaps**
- Postsecondary Readiness**

As a school of choice, ACA is a proven opportunity for enriched and accelerated learning in our community. ACA continues to utilize norm referenced assessments in order to inform instructional programs and continuously improve our services to our students. In Fall of 2015, ACA began using the NWEA MAP assessment for assessing our students' progress on our learning objectives. Summary results of the first assessment are available as addendum B. The students of ACA performed very well with almost 90% of our students meeting or exceeding the national norm average RIT score for their grade level.

Additional to the financial reporting available in the TAPR, the Division of School Finance provides a PEIMS Financial Standards Report of 2013-14 Financial Actual Information. These reports are included as addendum C.

## **Section 2 – Campus Performance Objectives**

Each Texas school is compelled to design strategic goals for the coming year through a Campus Improvement Plan. These strategic goals are driven by campus performance data with the TAPR.

ACA Middle School allocated local, state, and federal resources that would impact three state-level prioritized areas:

- Improve the percentage of students who meet standard or score “advanced” on the Science STAAR exam.
- Improve the percentage of students who score “Advanced” on the Social Studies STAAR exam.
- Improve the percentage of students who score “Advanced” on the EOC level exams. ( Algebra 1 and Biology)

Overall, ACA Middle School performance on the STAAR and EOC assessments earned the campus five (5) distinction designations along with the accountability rating of “met standard.”

Thanks to the dedicated educators at **ACA Middle School** and the hard work of our students and families, we were able to improve upon several of our goals from the 2014-2015 school year. The percentage of students that “met standard” on the Social Studies assessment increased by 7% points moving from 81% to 88%. This increase achieved our goal of receiving Academic Distinction in Social Studies for the 2014-2015 school year. This year, we plan to continue to improve the Social Studies scores by striving to increase the percentage of students scoring “advanced” on the Social Studies assessment. We also improved the percentage of students who “met standard” on the 7<sup>th</sup> grade writing exam by 4% points increasing from 91% to 95%.

We did notice last year that with the introduction of the Biology class, our Science scores struggled in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade assessment. We are making a goal this year to improve the percentage of students who meet standard on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science assessment.

**ACA Intermediate** allocated local, state, and federal resources to these state-level prioritized areas:

- Fourth grade focus on improving Writing scores from the 2013/14 school year.
  - a. 2014 89% Passing and 9% Advanced
  - b. 2015 83% Passing and 14% Advanced

The results of the 2015 Writing STAAR increased the Advanced Passing Rate. This was a goal carried over from the previous school year. The continued focus on improving Writing is resulting in a positive trend.

- Grades 3-5 focus on improving the student performance on all tested content areas by increasing the advanced scores.

The results revealed the following:

- Third Grade Reading Advanced Scores 2015 33% and 2014 33%
- Fourth Grade Reading Advanced Scored 2015 40% and 2014 24%
- Fourth Grade Writing Advanced scores: 2015 14% and 2014 9%
- Fifth Grade Reading Advanced scores: 2015 39% and 2014 32%

- Fifth Grade Science Advanced scores: 2015 22% and 2014 22%

These results indicated continued improvement in Reading in grades 3-5. A slight increase in Writing and the same advanced score in Science.

- A teacher attrition rate of less than 8% for the 2014/15 school year.

The results indicated a teacher attrition rate for 2013/14 of 16% and a teacher attrition rate of 16% for 2015. The indication for the 2014/15 school year for attrition was related to spouse relocations and distance from home to ACA Intermediate.

**ACA Primary** assessed data and set goals in using monthly progress monitoring to drive instruction, implementing targeted math and reading interventions with grade level tutors during the school day, and strengthening home support by education parents each nine weeks on various home resources. Evaluation of these goals demonstrated strong growth and use of these resources. ACA Primary will continue to work on strengthening vocabulary instruction, maintaining high behavioral and academic expectations, and using research on learning to improve our instructional program.

**District Accreditation Status** - Each district annual report must include the 2014–15 accreditation status according to Texas Education Code §39.051. The accreditation statuses can be accessed online at <http://tea.texas.gov/accredstatus/>. Arlington Classics Academy's status is accredited.

### **Section 3 – Report on Violent or Criminal Incidents**

Texas statute requires every district to publish a report on violent or criminal incidents at their schools. ACA is proud to be a safe place for students, families, and staff.

ACA reports zero (0) student violent or criminal incidents that occurred on any campus for the 2014-15 school year.

ACA has adopted and follows school violence prevention and intervention policies and procedures that ensure the safety of our students to the best of our ability. Campus efforts in drug awareness and violence/bullying prevention include inviting officers to discuss the power of good choices as well as the "Right to Your Light" project and assembly.

The Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1994 requires school district to evaluate high school students for safety and drug awareness and report the findings from those evaluations. ACA currently does not enroll high school students and; therefore, this requirement does not apply.

### **Section 4 – Reports of Student Enrollment and Academic Performance (TEC §51.043(e))**

ACA is an open-enrollment charter school that served students in grades Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2014-15 school year. Therefore, ACA is not included in this report.

**Section 5 – HB 5 TEC 39.0545 Evaluation of Performance in Community and Student Engagement & Compliance**

Each year, a committee of school stakeholders meets to evaluate ACA regarding nine (9) required indicators: compliance with statutory reporting and policy requirements, digital learning, 21<sup>st</sup> century workforce development, community and parent involvement, dropout prevention, educational programs for G/T students, wellness and physical education, second language acquisition programs, and fine arts. The committee met in May of 2015. Their report is attached as addendum D.
